

# JANUARY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS



## **January 7 Standing Committees Meeting**

- Presentation received from the OPP Detachment Commander Staff Sergeant Shawn Trudeau.
- Monthly reports were received from the Environmental Manager, Public Works Manager, Fire Chief, BISB and BESB and the CAO-Treasurer.
- The DWQMS Operation Plan for the Stirling-Rawdon drinking water system was received with recommendation to Council to endorse the operational plan.
- Report from the Deputy Clerk regarding an application to close a municipal road allowance (Lake Road), with recommendation to Council that the property be declared surplus and the policy be waived and that the subject portion of road allowance be transferred to the applicant who will cover all costs related to the transfer.
- Request for a hidden driveway sign received with recommendation to Council that staff install at their discretion.
- Correspondence received regarding the condition of former Highway 14.
- Report from the Economic Development Officer received with recommendation to Council that the following events/dates for 2025 be approved:
  - Stirling Santa Claus Parade – December 5
  - Springbrook Santa Claus Parade – December 7
  - Santa at the Covered Bridge – December 13
  - Free Goods Exchange Days – April 26 and September 27
- Several by-laws were reviewed with recommendations to Council as follows:
  - Traffic and Parking – no revisions at this time
  - Noise – revise and bring back
  - Administrative Penalties – new by-law
- Verbal report received regarding capital bridge reconstruction and the possibility of an increase in steel prices. Recommendation to Council that staff bring back a report for final decision.
- Verbal report regarding municipal insurance, with recommendation to Council that staff be directed to obtain insurance quotations.

  - 05-25 – Interim Tax Levy
